The winemakers of the Côte d'Or have been working together since 1957 on an impeccable terroir delivering Pinot noir, Aligoté and Chardonnay, from numerous appellations of Burgundy. 428 hectares of pure marvels, producing 3 million bottles all carrying the finesse, elegance and nuances of Hautes-Côtes de Beaune and Nuit.

TASTING NOTES

Garnet color with purple nuances. On the nose, the wine shines with its purity and complexity with touches of spices and cherries. The palate translates into a mineral framework affirmed by polished tannins. Pairings with veal chops with mushrooms

PRODUCT NOTES

Le Clos du Chapitre, a Nuits-Beaunoy monopoly, is located at the foot of the church in the village of Gevrey-Chambertin. This terroir exposed to the east and barely 1 hectare, enclosed by walls, is made up of brown soils and deep limestone.
