TASTING NOTES

Pretty crystal clear pale yellow color. Fruity nose exuding aromas of white-fleshed fruits, pear and vine peach. Lively attack but a beautiful roundness in the mid-palate which is expressed with floral notes of acacia type. The finish ends with mineral notes of chalk powder. Pairings with white meats and cheeses.

PRODUCT NOTES

This wine comes from our plots in the place called 'Conflans', one of the best terroirs in the appellation. The name of the vintage comes from the draft animals that worked on these plots.

PRODUCTION NOTES

Manual with sorting by plot into small 12kg crates. After settling, fermentation in concrete eggs and oak barrels including 5% new wood. Aged on fine lees in the same containers.
