Monthélie is a small village located between Volnay and Meursault. This vine was acquired in 2010, it is 1.16 hectares. It is very well oriented to the East at the top of the hillside and moreover not easy to cultivate. The soil is clayey and stony on the surface.

PRODUCTION NOTES

Manual harvest and de-stemmed. The aging lasts 18 months in barrels of which about a third are new.
