Near the Gironde in Bordeaux, the Château de la Tour de By vineyard rose to the level of exceptional Cru Bourgeois in 2003, from more than 100 hectares planted with noble grape varieties. Owned by the Pagès family since 1965, swept by the sun and a temperate climate, the Château blends traditional and modern winemaking processes to produce some of the best Médoc vintages.

TASTING NOTES

Very elegant ruby color. The nose is delicate and fine, already very expressive with its aromas of raspberries and redcurrants and a very well blended woodiness. On the palate, the attack is silky with a round, greedy mid-palate of cherry notes. The finish is marked by empyreumatic notes that give it great length.

PRODUCTION NOTES

Deep gravel soils with an alios subsoil. This poor, perfectly drained soil demands suffering and effort from the vines to create rare aromas. Médoc-style vinification, featuring long fermentations and maceration (3 weeks) before traditional ageing for 10 months. Traditional fining with egg whites before bottling.
