ABOUT THIS WINERY

All wine lovers immediately recognize the yellowish label adorned with the head of Bacchus by Louis Jadot, who is one of the most famous emblematic figures in wine. At the head of hundreds of plots in great wine-growing Burgundy, Maison Louis Jadot has been working its Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, Gamay and Aligoté vines for two centuries.

TASTING NOTES

Delicate and fine, this Monthélie 1er Cru from Maison Louis Jadot surprises us with its freshness and elegance. Floral notes mingle with red fruits. Pairing with rabbit with mustard and duck confit.

PRODUCT NOTES

The vines are located a few meters from Clos des Chênes de Volnay, a little further down the hillside. The exposure is the same: southeast. Champs Fulliot is a very beautiful terroir, one of the most delicate in Monthélie. This vine is over 30 years old.

PRODUCTION NOTES

The vats are punched twice a day during fermentation. Aging lasts around 18 months in barrels from our cooperage, around a third of which are new.

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
