The two sons of legendary founder Danie de Wet now promote their wines from the Robertson Valley, greatly contributing to the growth.

TASTING NOTES

Bright and shiny color, Limestone Hill develops notes of grapefruit and walnut, with a complexity balanced by a nuanced elegance ending in a delicate and mineral maturity.

The soils rich in limestone allow this Chardonnay to emit optimal varietal expression in a mantle of rich complexity.

WINEMAKING NOTES

The grapes are harvested in the cool of the morning. Once the destemming, pressing and overnight settling is complete, the juice is drawn off and pumped into stainless steel tanks for alcoholic fermentation. The wine is left on fine lees at controlled temperatures. The riddling of the lees ensures maximum flavor in the wine. Aging in
