“ The 2013 Morgon Côte du Py has a taut bouquet, black cherry and blackcurrant notes, with a light marine influence that distinguishes it from the 2013 Morgon. The palate is medium-bodied with a smooth, fleshy mouthfeel. The texture is a little grainier than the Morgon, there is slightly more backbone with a saline tang right on the finish. This is a finely made Côte du Py to drink over the next 8 to 10 years. ”
