

## Résonance – Louis Jadot Estates Willamette Valley Pinot Noir 2019



Full bottle 1,352 g. 17 months in 30% new French oak. Certified organic viticulture. This really REALLY needs air. I realise many of my tasting notes indicate when decanting is necessary but I recommend pouring a bit into a glass, sticking the cork back in this and shaking it. I originally had this sitting at a 15.5 before it opened. It's incredibly dry, no sweet fruit at all, lots of extract. Herbal, lightly bitter bark quality, purple violets, dense and extracted, considering the vintage. (SCJ)
