Reduction and wood dominate. The rich, round and moderately generous flavors possess excellent intensity along with a succulent mid-palate that concludes in a powerful and serious finish where the bright acidity is borderline drying. There is some gas present which exacerbates the suggestion of dryness so my projected range should be viewed a provisory.
